Choraegus ShareMusic Rehearsal Notes

General

There are a number of syncopations which don't necessarily follow the natural syllable stresses (e.g. measures 10-11). Learn them precisely!

Choir

You should give measures 20 and 42 some special attention - I've found that the moving parts require a bit of work.

Accompanist

Remember, the initial notation is "*senza pedale*" (without pedal). It's there to keep the accompaniment sounding clean.
